Having gained an MSc in Education for Sustainability, he has worked extensively as an ESD advisor to the Welsh Assembly Government, the Higher Education Academy in England, the EAUC and others. He has widely published on the subject (see [rolfjucker.net](http://rolfjucker.net)), amongst others *Our Common Illiteracy. Education as if the Earth and People mattered* (2002). His research interests relate to embedding systemic change and skills for a sustainable future.
