PRINCE2™

PRINCE2™ (PROjects IN a CONTROLLED Environment) describes the processes and procedures to coordinate effective project management. Aspects such as how to design, supervise and evaluate the project, how to manage people, resources and activities, as well as what to do if the project has to be adjusted when it's not developing as planned will be covered.

In using the PRINCE2™ methodology each process is specified with its key inputs and outputs and with specific goals and activities to be carried out, which gives automatic control of any deviations from the plan. Divided into manageable stages, the method enables a highly efficient control of resources.

PRINCE2™ is the Trade Mark of The Office of Government Commerce

PRINCE2™ is known as an industry standard for project management.

This course operates as either a stand-alone 2 day 'Foundation' course (introducing the basic theory and requirements of the PRINCE2™ approach), or can be taken as a full 5 day course – extending the Foundation course to cover additional practice elements with a final 'Practitioner' exam.

What is this course about?

The aim of this course is to enable delegates to apply PRINCE2™ structured project management methodology in their work for effective project delivery and outcomes.

- Describe the business justification
- Define an organisation structure for the project management team
