

Emergency Short Term Loans

Students can access Emergency Short Term Loans if the first instalment of their Undergraduate Student Loan is delayed (after the first day of the Autumn term). These loans are £50 per week for a maximum of 5 weeks, and are meant to cover basic living costs for example food.

Eligible Students

Students must:

- be enrolled on an undergraduate degree at the University of Gloucestershire
- be a full-time 'Home' student
- be awaiting their first instalment of Maintenance Loan (Autumn term)

How to Apply

Students will need to go to the Income Team's office at Park Campus – OW002. There is a very short application form to complete. Students will need to bring their University ID card or another form of ID when applying.

How to repay

Repayment is due as soon as the first maintenance loan instalment is received. Funds can be repaid via the MyBills system <https://mybills.glos.ac.uk/> An invoice will be raised if repayment is not received in a timely manner.
