

Financial Assistance Fund 2017/18

The University has established a Financial Assistance Fund for 2017/18. This fund will be open to applications from students who can demonstrate financial hardship. Awards from the Financial Assistance Fund are means tested on each student's personal income and expenditure and as such are not guaranteed.

Eligible Students

Students must:

- be enrolled on a degree or postgraduate qualification at the University of Gloucestershire
- be a 'Home' or EU student (International students are not eligible to apply for the Financial Assistance Fund)
- have taken out their full entitlement of Maintenance Loan 2017/18
- be studying on a University campus, not at a franchised college

How to Apply

Hard copy application forms will be available from any Helpzone from the start of term, as well as on our website for students to download. Award amounts cannot be estimated until a completed form is submitted. Applications will be accepted from the first day of Fresher's week in September 2017.
