Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to all Scholarships and Bursaries offered through the International Development Centre at the University of Gloucestershire. Each scholarship or bursary may have additional terms and conditions.

1. Applicants must hold an offer of a place of study on a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate course at the University of Gloucestershire starting in 2015.
2. All scholarship applicants/recipients must be overseas fee payers.
3. Applicants must have no outstanding offer conditions attached to their place of study except for the tuition fee deposit and passport photocopy.
4. Scholarship applicants must complete the scholarship application form.
5. Certified copies/notarised copied of your highest qualification will be required to verify your results/qualifications.
6. The closing date for applications is Friday 19 June 2015 for the scholarships; scholarship applications received after this date will not be considered. Scholarship applications will be considered by a Scholarship Award Panel. The Panel may consider the following aspects: academic performance, English language, merit of personal statement.
7. The Scholarship Award Panel 's decision will be finalised by the end of June 2014 and applicants will be notified of the decision on their application by email at the beginning of July 2015.
8. The Scholarship Award Panel 's decision will be finalised at the end of June 2015 and applicants will be notified of the decision on their application by email at the beginning of July 2015. Successful scholarship applicants must meet any outstanding conditions (i.e. tuition fee deposit / passport photocopy) by the 29th August 2014 to receive the scholarship.
9. Once awarded application-based scholarships cannot be deferred to following entry points. Automatic awards can be deferred while the scholarship programme continues to be in operation
10. Successful scholarship applicants must meet any outstanding conditions (i.e. tuition fee deposit / passport photocopy) by 14 August 2015 to receive the scholarship.

The Award

1. The scholarships will not be paid in cash. Scholarships will be deducted from the first year's tuition fees on arrival at the University of Gloucestershire.
2. Recipients must not be in receipt of a full scholarship from any other source.
3. In the first term at the University of Gloucestershire, all successful scholarship winners will be invited to attend a reception to receive their award certificate.
4. Scholarship winners will be asked to provide a case study which may be used in university publications or on the website.
5. Students will only be entitled to claim one scholarship or bursary. The award of the highest value will be granted.
