What should I bring?
Cleaning products: Bathroom Cleaner, Mold Remover, Kitchen and Toilet Cleaner etc.

Your motor vehicle (there is a no motor vehicle rule for Halls students)
Pets (not allowed)
Deep fat frying equipment (not allowed)
Vacuum Cleaner (included)
A mop and bucket and a dustpan and brush (included)

Summary of key points of the licence

Rules and regulations within Halls of Residence (see our Terms and Conditions for full details.)

If you withdraw or are withdrawn from University you will be liable for a four week cancellation fee once you have completed the process, vacated and returned your room keys.
You may transfer to another Halls room after the first three weeks on term (subject to a £50 fee.)
