This document details the key amendments made to the previous made to the Student Contract in preparation for the new Academic Year commencing 1 August 2018.

1.	<p>Library / IT guidelines replaced by the following policies:</p> <p>IT Acceptable Use Policy, User Account Policy, Internet Policy, Email Policy, Network and Wireless Policy</p>
2.	<p>Clarification of to whom the Student Contract applies - Clause 1.4:</p> <p>This Contract supersedes previously issued Student Contracts. It applies to all applicants to the University accepting offers from 1 August 2018 and all students enrolling/re-enrolling on a course from that date.</p>
3.	<p>Insertion of new clause 5.2:</p> <p>The University reserves the right to maintain checks on any outstanding debts of students enrolled previously with the University. This may result in the enrolment offer being revoked or cancelled retrospectively if repayment plans for any outstanding debt cannot be agreed.</p>
4.	<p>Insertion of new Clause 8:</p> <p>8.1 The University holds information about all applicants to the University and all students at the University. The personal data (including special category personal data) held by the University will include information that you provide as part of the application and enrolment process. Further information about the personal data the University holds and processes is outlined in the Student Privacy Notice.</p> <p>8.2 The University has implemented Learning Analytics, a system to review the information it holds on students to give them a greater awareness of how they are studying. The Learning Analytics system makes statistical analyses of how each student is using the various IT systems provided for their studies. It provides a guide to the student on how they compare to their peer group and identifies students that would benefit from personalised interventions. All of the information is for the student's benefit and is not used in the assessment of a student's academic work.
